

WMTBOC 2011 TRAINING CAMPS

The WMTBOC 2011 Organizing Committee is offering a first training camp from April 18 to 30, 2011 for all athletes that intend to take part in the 2011 World MTB-Orienteering Championships in Italy. A second training camp will be organized from August 2 to 15, 2011 just prior to the Event.

In both training camps, the bikers will only find controls out in the forest but there will not be any time-keeping apart from one training session per training camp where the organizers will provide an official sport-ident time keeping.

Location:

The Official **WMTBOC-2011 Training Camps** will take place in Brendola, Arcugnano, Nanto-San Giovanni in Monte and Mussolente in the Province of Vicenza.

Programme:

4 training maps with controls on the terrain from April 18 to 30, 2011

Brendola – only controls on the terrain

(only on April 23, 2011 from 10.00 to 14.00 sport-ident time keeping)

Arcugnano/Lake Fimon - only controls on the terrain

Nanto – San Giovanni in Monte – only controls on the terrain

Mussolente - only controls on the terrain

Price of the Training Camp: map package: 30 euro/per person

The map packages can be obtained from the front desk of Hotel Castelli in Montecchio Maggiore **(Event Centre for the WMTBOC 2011)** from April 17, 2011. Each envelop contains a full set of 4 maps and the driving directions to the training areas.

From Lonigo to Nanto - San Giovanni in Monte (training map): 21 km

From Lonigo e to Brendola (training map): 7 km

From Lonigo to Arcugnano/Lake of Fimon (training map): 25 km

From Lonigo to Mussolente (training map): 67 km

With reference to the art. 14.3 of the Competition Rules For International Orienteering Federation, the competition terrain for the World MTBO Championships (WOC-JWOC) Event is embargoed for the time period from 20.12.2009 to 01.09.2011.

The embargoed area is constantly under control by mapmakers and course setters.

It is possible to train in the embargoed areas only during official training camps and the O- bikers can use only maps obtained from the organizers. It must be clear that during training camp, o-bikers have to follow the rules of the Italian road code, maintain the right side on the road/path and the priority must be given to traffic coming from right side (bikes, cars, tractors, etc).

The roads and paths are not closed to traffic in the training area. Road crossings are unattended, so stop and check before you cross the roads/paths. The areas are also open to hunters.
